




Clamp-On Mounting Plate

INSTALLATION OF YOUR NEW CLAMP-ON MOUNTING PLATES


Installation Tools Required


- Tape Measure: For measuring between the clamps
- · Pencil: For marking the plate before cutting
- Square Edge: For ensuring square cuts
- Hacksaw, Bandsaw or Chopsaw: For cutting the aluminum plate to length IMPORTANT NOTE: Use blades for aluminum and observe all safety instructions for the tool use!
- Metal File: For removing burrs or rough edges
- "Blue" Thread Locking Fluid (Removable type, usually found in hand tools area at retailers)
- 3/16" Hex Wrench: For tightening the fasteners
- · Sharp Bladed Knife: For curved arch applications only

Measuring & Cutting the Plate to Length



- 1) Select the reducer insert to suit your 3/4" 1" Pipe or 1" x 1-1/2" Oval Pipe (see below for curved tower pipes).
- 2) Install both top clamp halves and reducers on the tower pipe, under the canvas.
- Measure between the edge/face shown, mark one end and cut the ribbed plate squarely to length.
- 4) After cutting to length, remove any rough edges or burrs from both ends.





- 7) Hinge the lower clamp half around the pivoting hook& ledge so that it wraps around the lower portion of the reducer.
- 8) Center the plate so that the lower clamp fits up inside the lower plate ribs as it wraps around.
- 9) Apply a "Blue" Thread Locking Fluid (not supplied) to one of the fastener threads and start the fastener into the upper center hole, but do not fully tighten.
- 10) Apply "Blue" Thread Locking Fluid to the other 2 fasteners and start the threads into the upper clamp, then evenly hand tighten all three fasteners so as to gradually compress the flexible rubber reducer insert onto the tower pipe.
- 11) Repeat for the other clamp-end and then recheck all 6 hand-tightened fasteners after approximately 30 minutes (the reducer inserts will settle under clamping pressure).
- 12) Recheck the fastener tightness after 24 hours for any further settling before installing any outrigger mounts or accessories onto the mounting plate.





TACO Grand Slam 370 Mounts



- · Fully adjustable from under the top
- For use on both soft and hard tops
- Fold-up crank handle for maximum clearance

TACO Grand Slam 270 Mounts



- 12 locking positions
- Rotator handle positioning installs to avoid obstruction
- Rotate outrigger position from under the top
- · Lay down arm for bridges & trailering

TACO Sport Slam Mounts



- · Easy to install
- · Pull pin for multiple fishing positions
- · Operates above the top
- · Lay down arm

TACO Outrigger Line Caddy



- Clamp to Tele-Outriggers
- Eliminates rigging from tangles when retracted
